of Mytes and men.



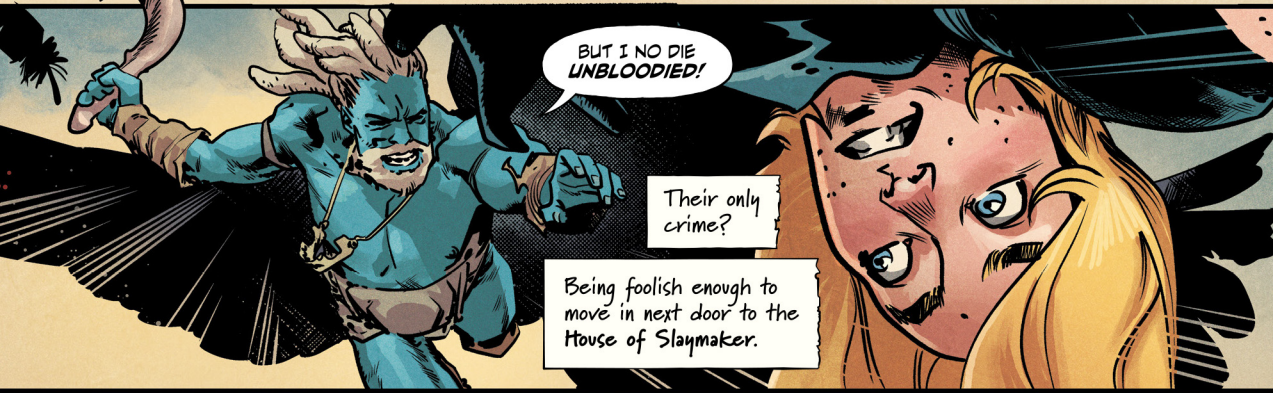

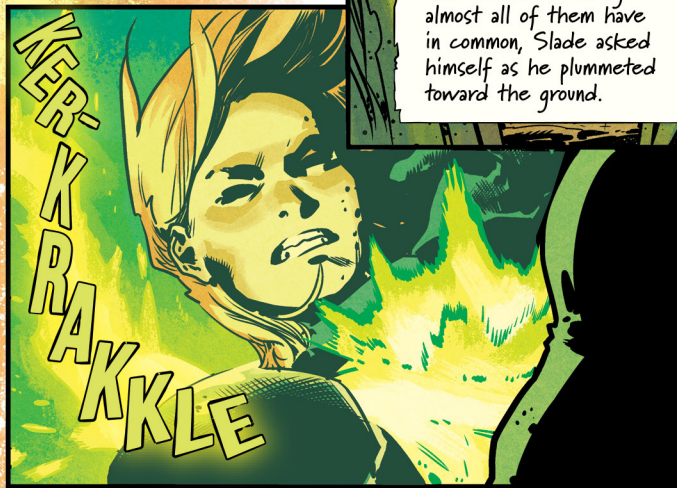
